Feed: Choice Food Pantry

- Healthy Food for ALL model provides guests with healthy, nutrient dense food choices
- 1,464 adults and 871 children received food and household, personal and baby care items
- Nearly 20% of CAIN’s service area residents shopped at the pantry
- CAIN Café provides healthy food choices and recipes using fresh produce



Nourish: Phil's Place

- Provides warm meals, fosters belonging, and builds community
- 64 guests each week enjoyed over 5000 meals
- 10 church and community groups provide and serve the meals

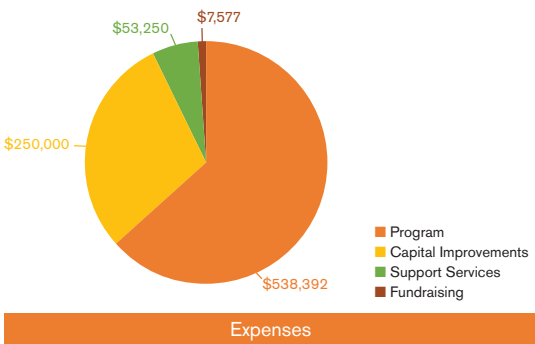
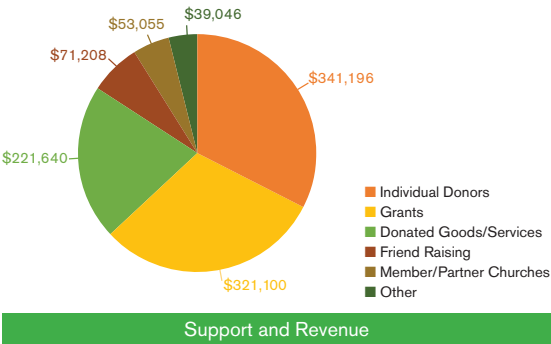


Shelter: Grace Place

- \$6,000 in donated specialized services from our professional partners

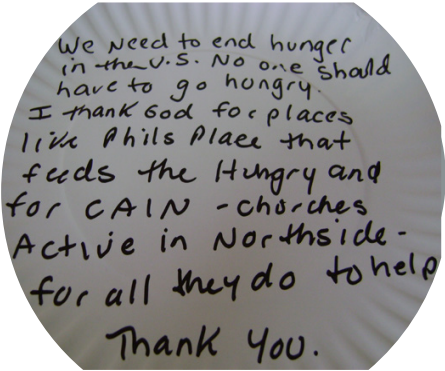
